**24 HR LAW ENFORCEMENT GROUND FIGHTING INSTRUCTOR
COURSE**

This 24 hr course is the only CO P.O.S.T. approved class of its kind. This system is being used by several Denver Metro area Law Enforcement Agencies.

The course covers use of force and instructor liability issues as the following skills: 1) Standing self-defense, including striking 2) Takedown defense 3) Takedowns 4) Defense against strikes on the ground 5) Escaping bad position on the ground 6) Controlling a subject on the ground 7) Weapons defense

This is a very physical class. Class format consists of a warm-up and stretching at the beginning of morning and afternoon sessions, learning and drilling technique, and Randori.

Instructor candidates will complete a practical exam to demonstrate their ability to teach the techniques precisely. Upon completion instructors will be certified to teach to their agency. Certification is valid for one year.



INSTRUCTOR JOAQUIN BACA

Joaquin is a 17 year veteran officer with the Lakewood Police Department. He has been an Arrest Control/Defensive Tactics instructor since 1998. He is a certified LPD Arrest Control instructor and F.B.I. Defensive Tactics instructor. Joaquin is a former patrol officer, academy instructor and former S.W.A.T. operator and former member of the CO P.O.S.T. Arrest Control subject matter expert committee.

Joaquin is a black belt in Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu under Professor J.J. Pugsley and previously trained under Shane Pitts, David Ruiz, and Steve Hordinski. He also holds a black belt in Kung Fu San Soo.
