## **Upcoming Important Dates**

- √ 3/1/2016-Applications will be accepted for both the In-Service Continuing Education Grant Programs and the Region Grant Programs
- √ 3/31/2016 Applications for both programs are due
- POST anticipates approximately \$3.9 million available award in the upcoming year
- Funds awarded through this grant cycle will not be available until July 1,2016

#### WHAT GRANT CAN YOU APPLY FOR?

- **✓ POST designated Training Regions and Training Providers (CSOC, COVA, etc.)**, non-profit, college or university are eligible to apply for the Training Region Grant
- ✓ Any local government (police department, sheriff's office, etc.), may apply for the In-Service Continuing Education Grant

#### **GRANT PROGRAM DIFFERENCES**

- > POST REGION GRANT PROGRAM
- Training, scholarships and equipment which will be available to all law enforcement agencies within the designated Training Region should be applied for through the Region Grant Program
- > In-Service Continuing Education Grant Program
- Agencies that want to purchase equipment, on-line training subscriptions, or training to meet in-service requirements that will be available to their agency should apply through the In-Service Continuing Education Grant Program

- Agencies wishing to submit funding requests through their Region must contact their Training Region Coordinator prior to March 1, 2016

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TRAINING

- ✓ Employed Colorado peace officers are able to benefit from training programs under the Training Region Grant Program.
- ✓ The In-Service Continuing Education Grant Program is restricted to employed <u>certified</u> Colorado peace officers only.

# EXAMPLES OF WHAT FUNDING COVERS IN BOTH PROGRAMS

Travel costs for officers to attend in-state or out-of-statetraining which include:

- Tuition
- Commercial travel
- Lodging
- Per diem

- Mileage
- Class supplies
- Backfill

# EXAMPLES OF WHAT FUNDING COVERS IN BOTH GRANT PROGRAMS

## >Training equipment

- Arrest control equipment
- Simmunitions/training ammunition
- Simulators- Regions only
- Lap tops for training/projector systems/training room equipment
- Track car maintenance/range equipment
- On-line training subscriptions
- If you are applying for funds to purchase equipment you must provide formal quotes from the vendor with your application

# EXAMPLES OF WHAT FUNDING COVERS IN BOTH PROGRAMS

- ➤ If your agency would like to "host" training, POST funds pay for:
- Instructor fees (limits apply)
- Instructor travel costs (limits apply)
- Refreshments for training
- Printing/mailing/copying
- Class supplies for training
- Facility fee rental/range fees

# EXAMPLES OF WHAT FUNDING COVERS IN BOTH PROGRAMS

- ➤ Peace Officer Instructor Fee-\$400 per day or \$50 per hour of instruction
- Instructor fee for professional trainers are not limited to \$400 per day but reasonableness of cost will be taken into consideration
- Travel time may not be compensated to professional trainers
- Travel time of peace officer trainers may be compensated if more than 4 hours of driving time (restrictions apply)

### **EQUIPMENT PURCHASES**

- If you are purchasing equipment greater than \$500 you must keep inventory records and report to POST by June 30<sup>th</sup> every year for as long as you have possession of the equipment:
- Description of the equipment
- Serial number
- Acquisition date
- Cost of the equipment
- Location of the equipment
- Use and condition of the equipment
- Disposition data (how you got rid of it)

Reports/inventory records need to be sent to postgrants@coag.gov

## **Backfill**

- ➤ Backfill or OT if reimbursed for travel to and from or attending or conducting POST training
- Actual hourly salary, not to exceed \$50 per hour. Prior approval is required for requests that exceed this amount.
- Familiarize yourself with your training region's backfill policy to determine which grant program you should apply to prior to the March 1<sup>st</sup> application date.

#### **AWARDS**


- Awards will be made by June 10th, 2016 or sooner
- Full funding or partial funding
  - Agencies may be asked to prioritize their funding requests
- Grant Agreements or Purchase Orders will be prepared for signature by POST staff
- All funds must be expended and receipts turned into POST by June 30,2017 to be eligible for reimbursement
- If you are purchasing equipment you must take delivery of the equipment by June 30,2017

# **Grant Payments**

- > Grant payments are made on a reimbursement basis
- Payment request instructions will be sent to you with fully executed Grant Agreement or PO
- The agency pays the initial cost and POST reimburses for the cost at the completion of training or purchase of equipment
- If a financial hardship exists POST may approve your agency for "pre-pay"
- Invoices must be submitted within 60 days of the completion of training or delivery of equipment and no later than June 30th
  - Cost documentation is required and must be submitted at the time of payment request
